

THEME: **Communicable Diseases: Prevention and Control**



:Good Health is the Greatest of Human Blessings”

As a proud recipient of International School Award from British Council, the school continued to organize its international activities even during the pandemic. Activity 1 was commenced by science department of primary wing, under the theme **“Communicable Diseases: Prevention and Control”**. In the month of May, students from std. II and III participated in **‘Health Week’**, in which they learnt some simple yet effective ways to prevent such diseases. They were also introduced to some well-known Japanese cultural habits regarding cleanliness and personal hygiene through videos, which encouraged them to inculcate the same in their own daily routines. Further to highlight the role of healthy eating for a strong immunity, the students were engaged in an activity to prepare simple (fireless cooking), but nutritious meals by themselves. Students realized the importance of good health and showcased their understanding in **‘Slogan Writing’** activity based on theme **‘The True Wealth is Health’**. Their understanding was assessed by **‘Show and Tell’** activity, in which they were invited to share their gained knowledge of things that are helpful in preventing communicable diseases, such as hand sanitizers, face mask, water purifier, mosquito repellent etc.



prevents spread of infectious diseases.










Click from Slogan writing activity
