BCM Student Shines at KOMPTE Badminton Tournament

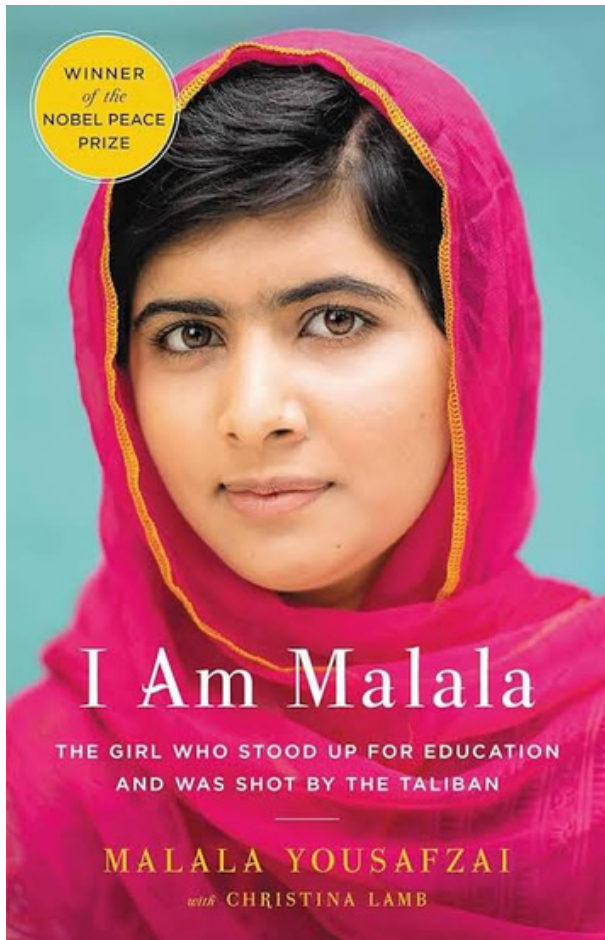
