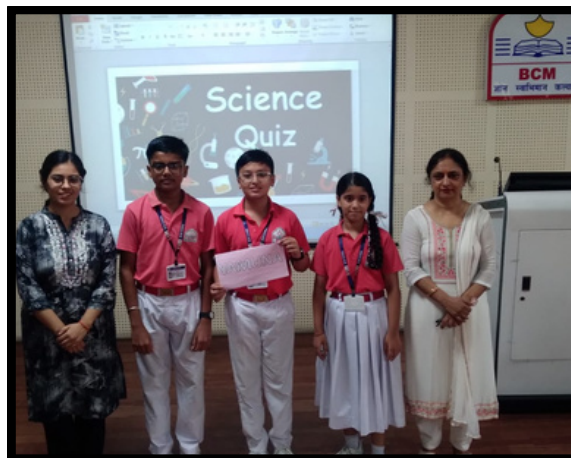


The Foundational Stage came alive with warmth and cheer as young learners celebrated International Friendship Day through a series of creative and heartwarming activities.

This enriching experience helped students develop a deeper appreciation for wildlife while sharpening their observation and analytical skills.

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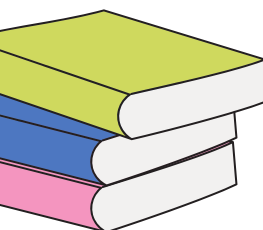
