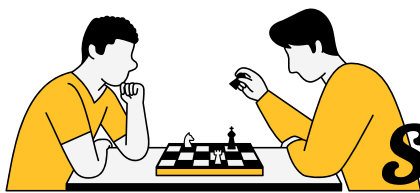


Mime Magic: BCM Receives Appreciation Award

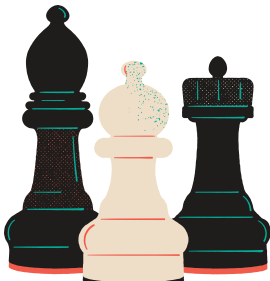

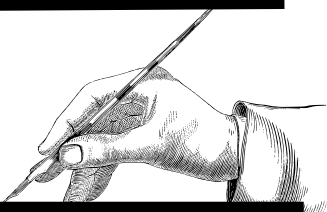
