The initiative successfully nurtured articulate expression and helped students become more confident communicators. Teachers noted visible improvement in pronunciation and clarity among the participants.

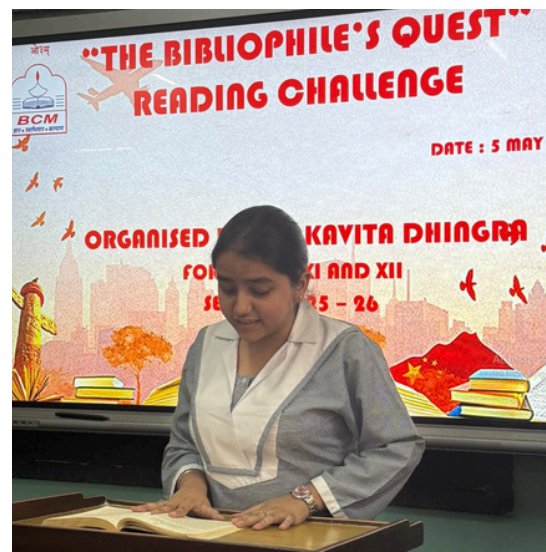
Top honours went to:

## LKG Students Discover the Magic of Science

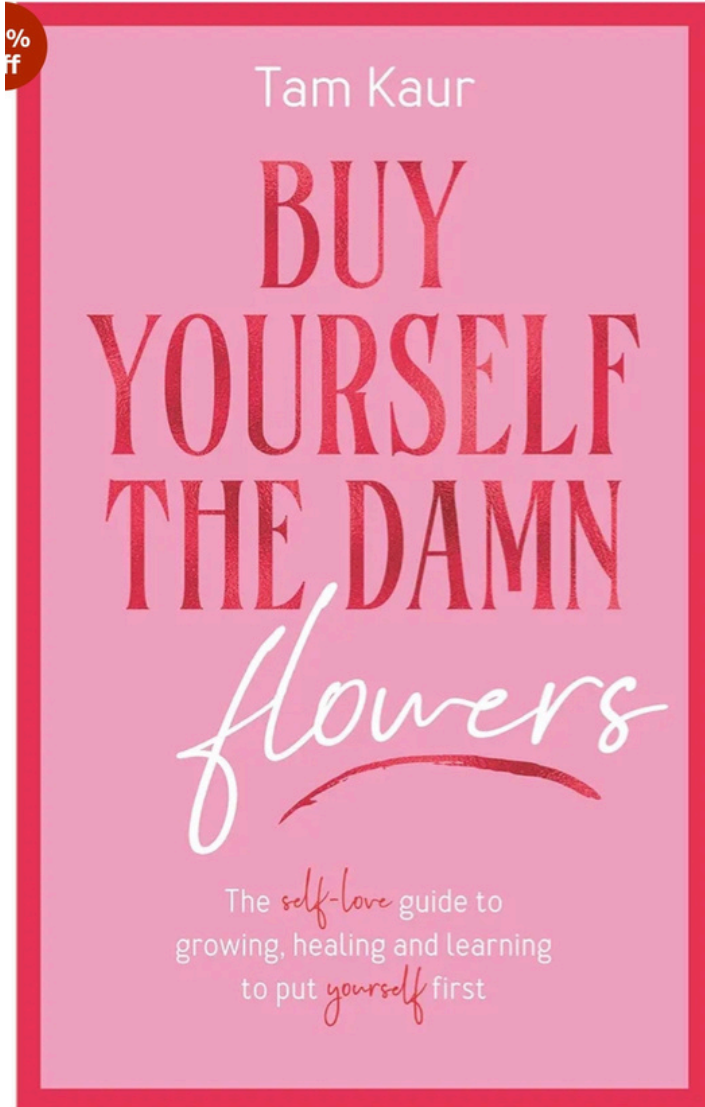
