The initiative was appreciated by both parents and the local community, reinforcing the school's commitment to holistic and responsible education.

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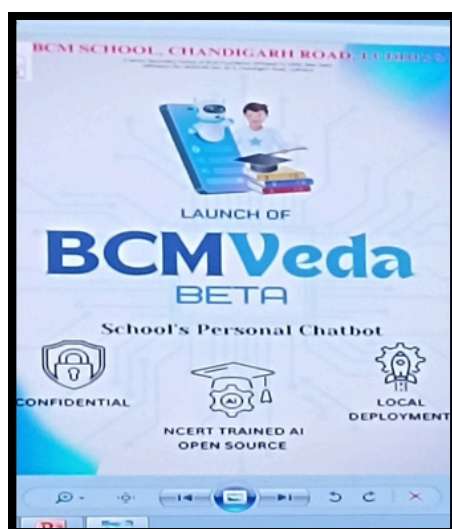
## Foundational Stage Celebrates World Athletics Day with Zeal
