Foundational Stage Unleashes the Word Wizards

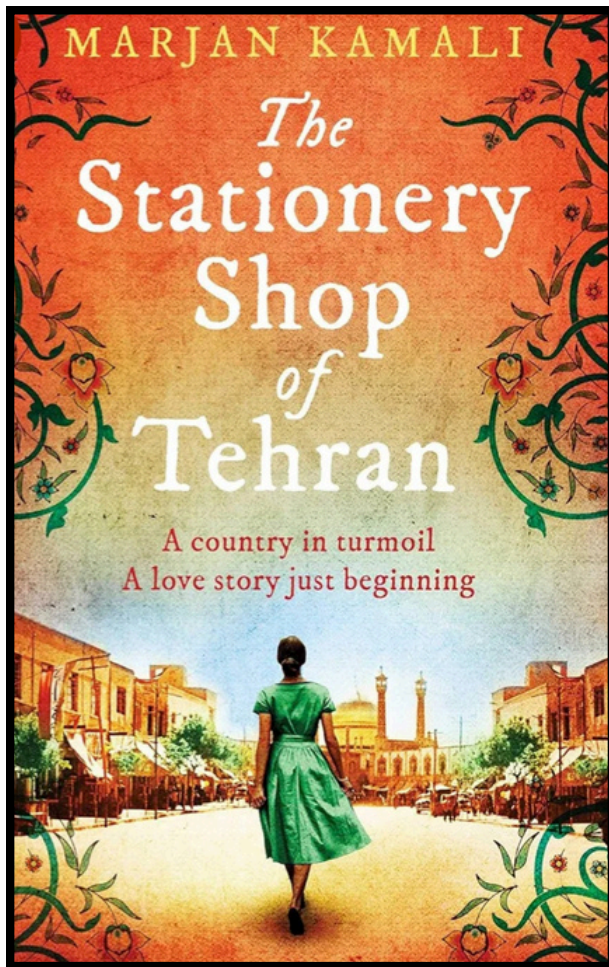
