This day in history: June 07

1893 – Mahatma Gandhi commits to nonviolent resistance (Satyagraha) for the first time after being thrown off a train in South Africa for refusing to move from a "whites-only" compartment. This incident became a turning point in his life and the beginning of his journey as a civil rights leader.
