The new Academic Session 2017-18 brings new aspirations and resolutions with it. Together we visualize our children's success and stand by them imparting complete support. Hence, an essential bond of understanding between us is the prerequisite to achieve our common goal i.e. the best possible grooming of our children.

We thank you for your cooperation received in the previous year and seek the same in future also.

Further, we bring this in your notice that **CBSE has restored Class X Board Examination** and remodeled assessment structure will be followed **w.e.f. the Academic Year 2017-18** as per the details given hereunder.

1. Scholastic Area

A. Board Examination (80 marks)

Student will take one Annual Examination at the end of the session covering the 100% syllabus of the subject and will have to secure minimum 33% in each subject. Marks and Grades both will be awarded for Individual Subjects. Students will be graded in 9 point grading scale.

B. Internal Assessment (20 marks)

Student has to secure 33% marks out of overall 20 marks earmarked in each subject.

Internal Assessment will consist of –

- 1. Periodic Test (10 Marks):** Three Periodic Tests, Pre-Mid, Mid-Term and Post Mid will be conducted in an Academic Year. Portion of syllabus will be cumulatively covered in these tests.
- 2. Note Book Submission (5 Marks):** The student will be assessed on the basis of regularity, punctuality, assignment completion, neatness and upkeep of note-book.
- 3. Subject Enrichment Activity (5 Marks):**
 - For Language 1, Language 2 & Optional Subject (Punjabi) – Activities to develop Speaking & Listening Skills
 - For Math & Science- Practical Lab Work
 - For Social Science- Map and Project Work

2. Co-Scholastic Activities:

Includes Work Education/Pre-vocational Education, Art Education, Health & Physical Education (Sports/Martial Arts/Yoga/NCC etc.)The student will be graded on a 5 point grading scale (A to E). No descriptive indicators will be reflected on report card. No up scaling will be done

3. Discipline:

Includes Attendance, Sincerity, Behavior (towards peers & teachers) and Moral Values. Class teacher will assess the student on a 5 point grading scale (A to E).

We place unshakable faith in you that you understand your responsibility and will take the same wisely.

Nevertheless, here is a humble reminder of our expectations from you.

1. Our children are our mirror image not only in appearance but in character too. Give them something nice to be looked up to. We must demonstrate the same discipline that we expect from our children.
2. Help them in packing their school bags according to the days' time-table to reduce burden on their tender shoulders. It will also give you a chance to keep a watch over their activities.

3. Check the School Diary on a regular basis for any instructions/ notes given by the class/ subject teachers. Also go through the school policies regarding Attendance, Regularity, Punctuality, Promotion Policy, School Discipline and other necessary details mentioned on (Page no. 11-25).
4. Send your ward to school in neat & clean uniform including neck-tie, belt, I-card.
5. Put fresh nutritious fruits and easily digestible meals in their snack box.
6. Encourage your ward to participate in out-door games and other Co-scholastic activities, Inter/Intra School competitions and many other additional learning opportunities like Cambridge, EduconVex, Antex, Silver zone, SOF Olympiads etc. offered by the school.
