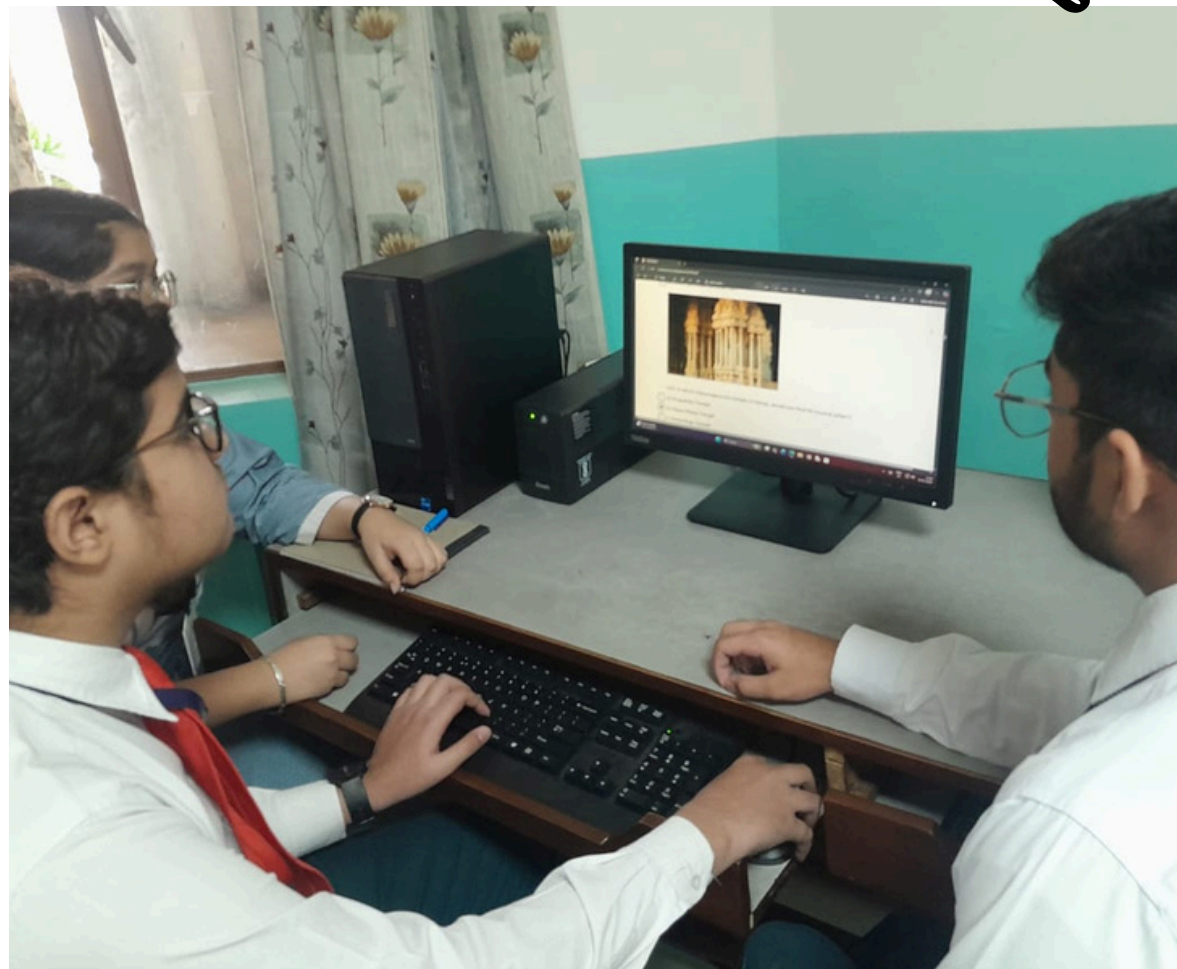

### About the Book

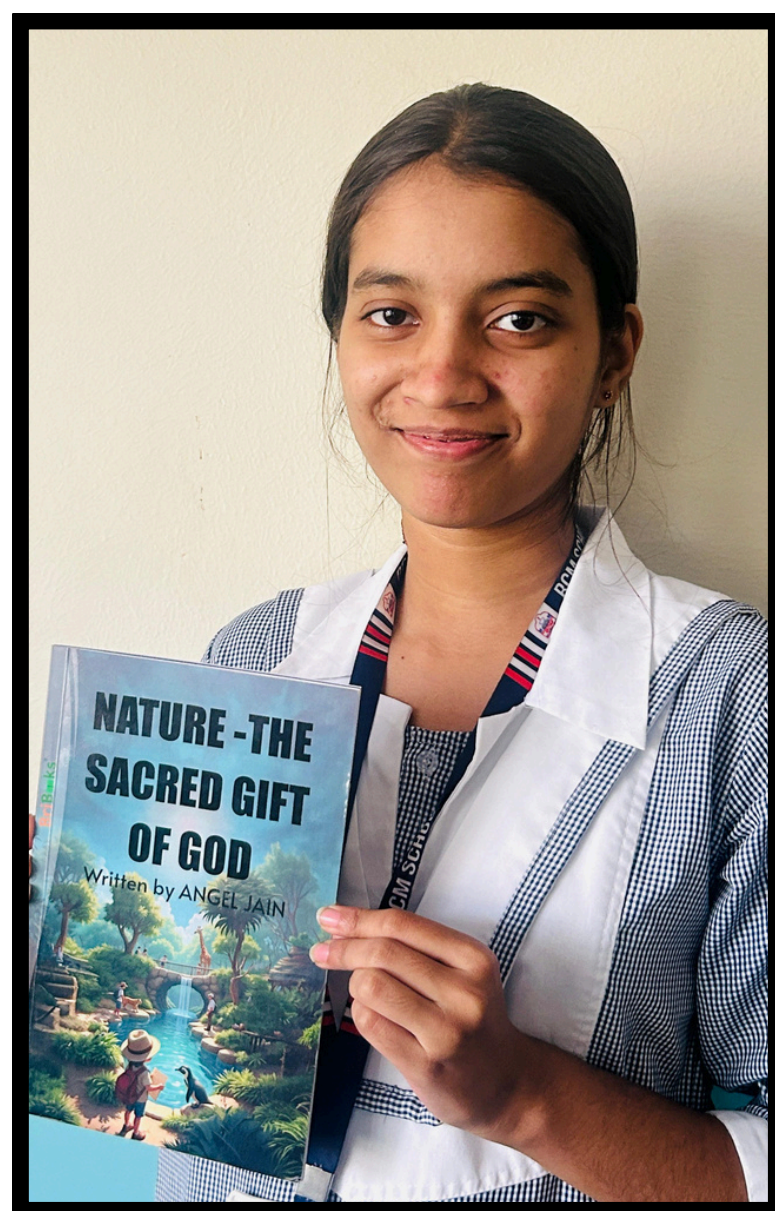
