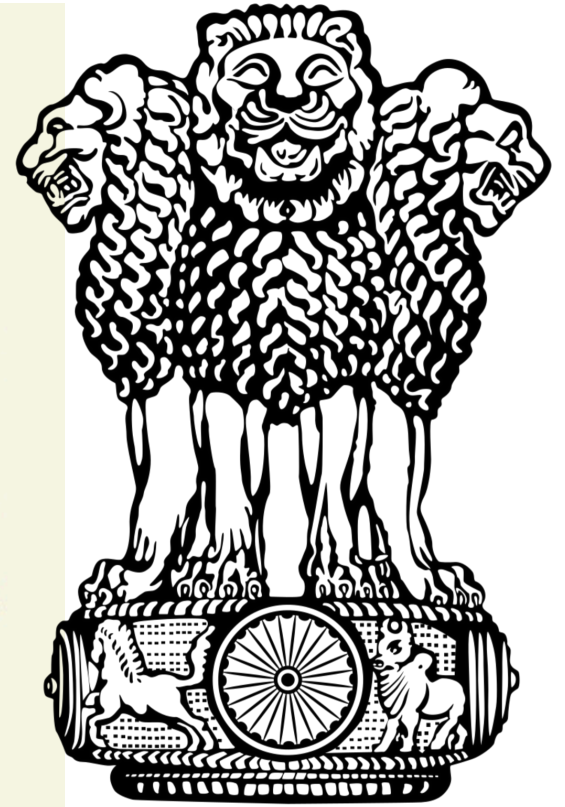

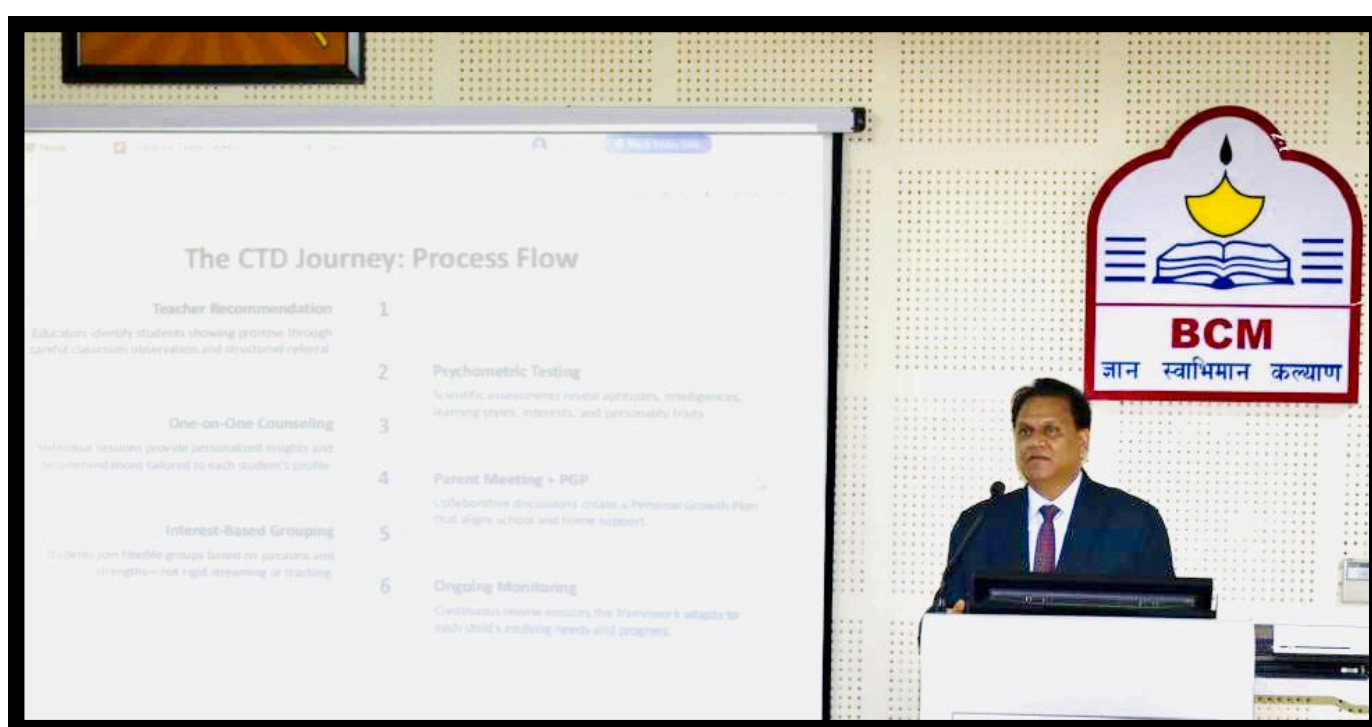
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PARENT ORIENTATION SESSION HELD FOR GRADE 5 CENTRE FOR TALENT DEVELOPMENT
