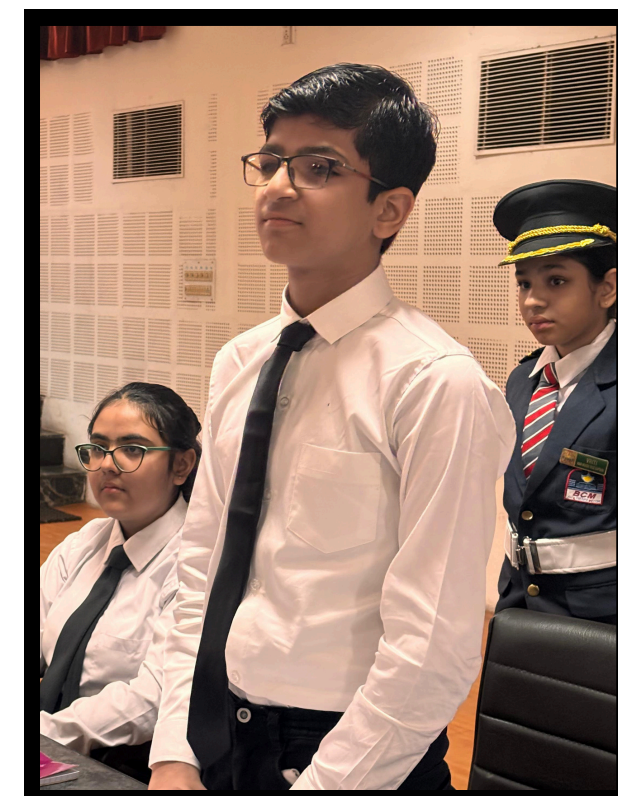

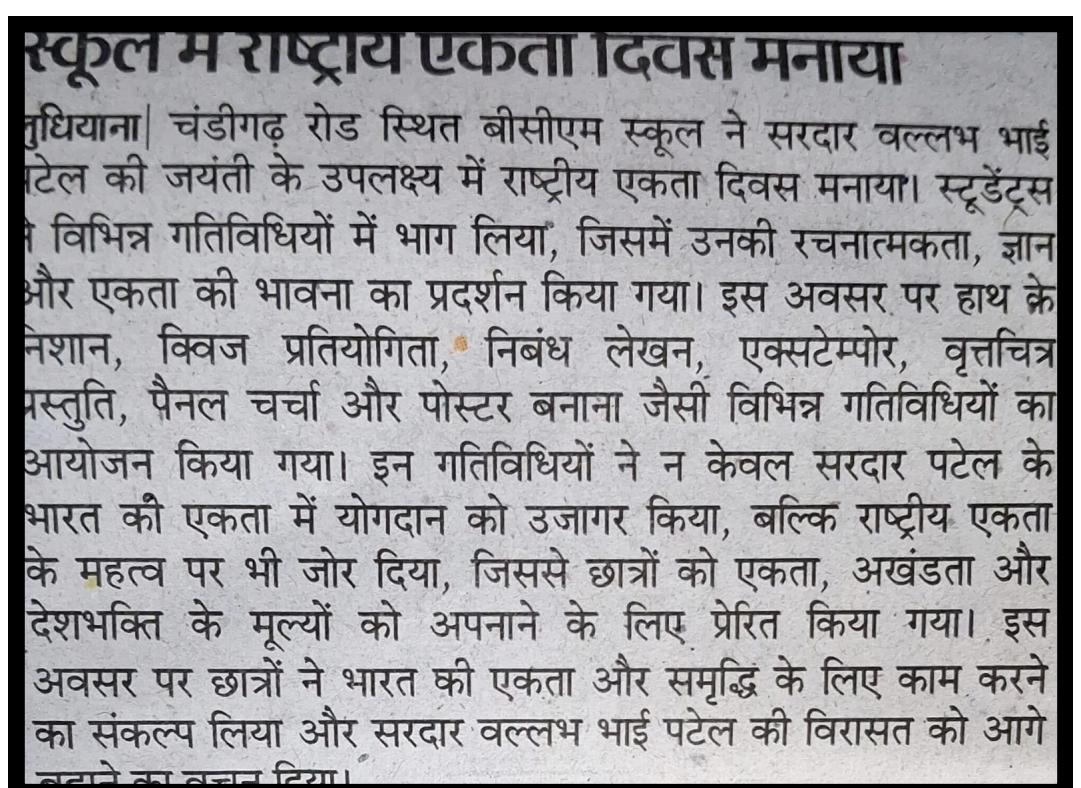
BCM SCHOOL OBSERVES RASHTRIYA EKTA WEEK WITH PATRIOTIC ZEAL
